Kindai makes big changes on its Main Campus

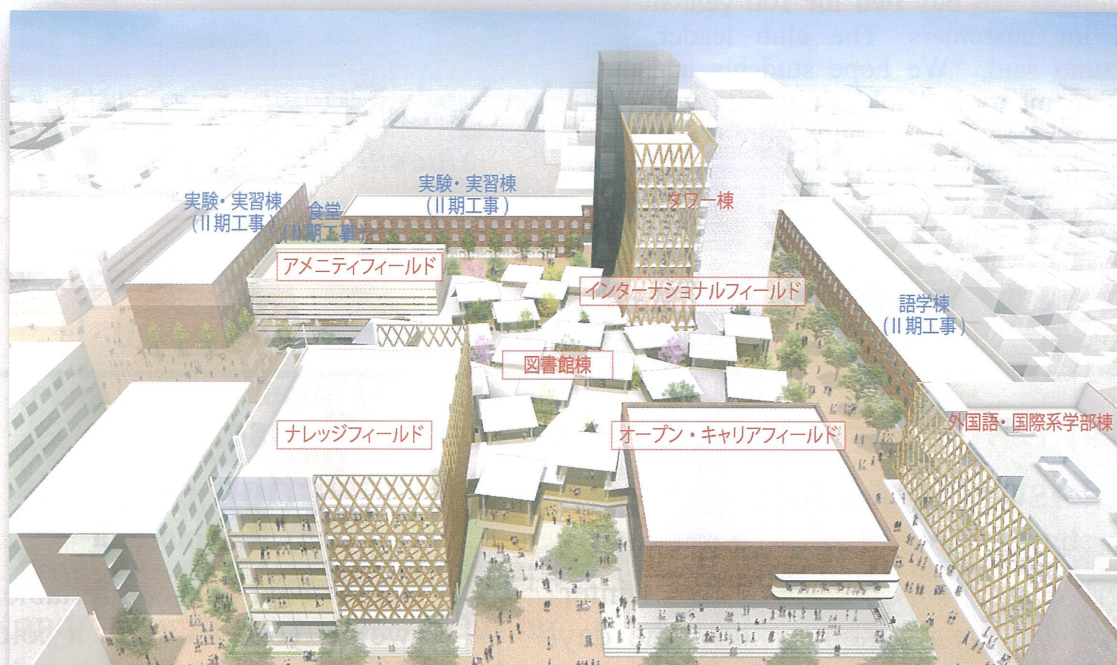
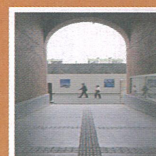


Image of the purposed new main campus buildings

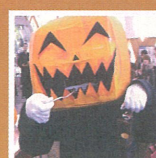

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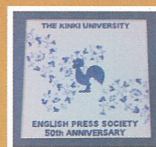

At the Career Center they have a lot of information about businesses and provide great support to students. The staff members will give you advice that highlights your strong points.

Mr. Ryousuke Doi, who is the Center's head, said, "There is no doubt that the world is paying attention to Kinki University. Every Kinki University student should be proud of the fact that they are all students here. In addition, if you have a lot of experiences while you are a student, your job-hunting will surely go well, too."

Job Hunting Advice

In society, we must do our best even when there is no answer. This spiritual challenge is an essential element that is required of students. To go through the door of the Career Center is also one of these challenges.

Moreover, the Career Center has introduced an appointment system so that you can consult with someone with whom you have **compatibility**, so keep going there until you meet this person. The staff will not only advise you about how to write your **résumé** but will also consult with you about your small worries until you receive an **informal promise of employment**. Until you are able to find a job, you will have the chance to communicate with the Career Center staff many times. Becoming accustomed to talking with people you do not know will make you less nervous about having an interview and will make it easier for you to job-hunt.

You should visit the Career Center to find

out about what you do not know and reduce your anxiety about finding a job. This is especially recommended for first year through third year students who have not started job-hunting yet.

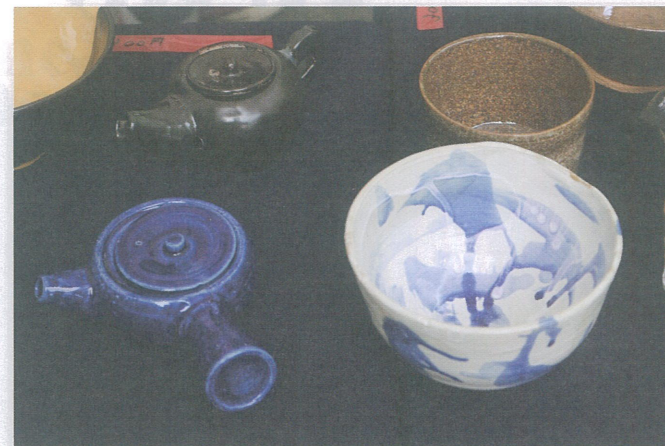
Ceramics Arts Sale

For these reasons, our physical condition may get worse from fall through winter because of our lifestyle and living environment. Let's maintain good health enjoy university life.

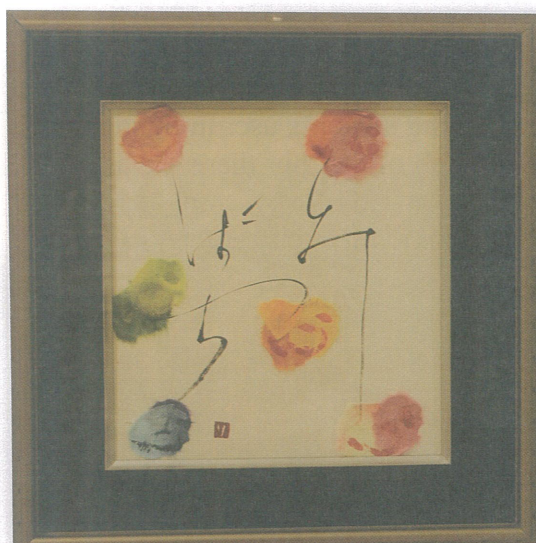
Causes and Prevention of Colds

Fall Cooking: Sweet Potato and Chestnut Sweets

This time, we will cook “Sweet potato and chestnut sweets”. Let’s try to cook!

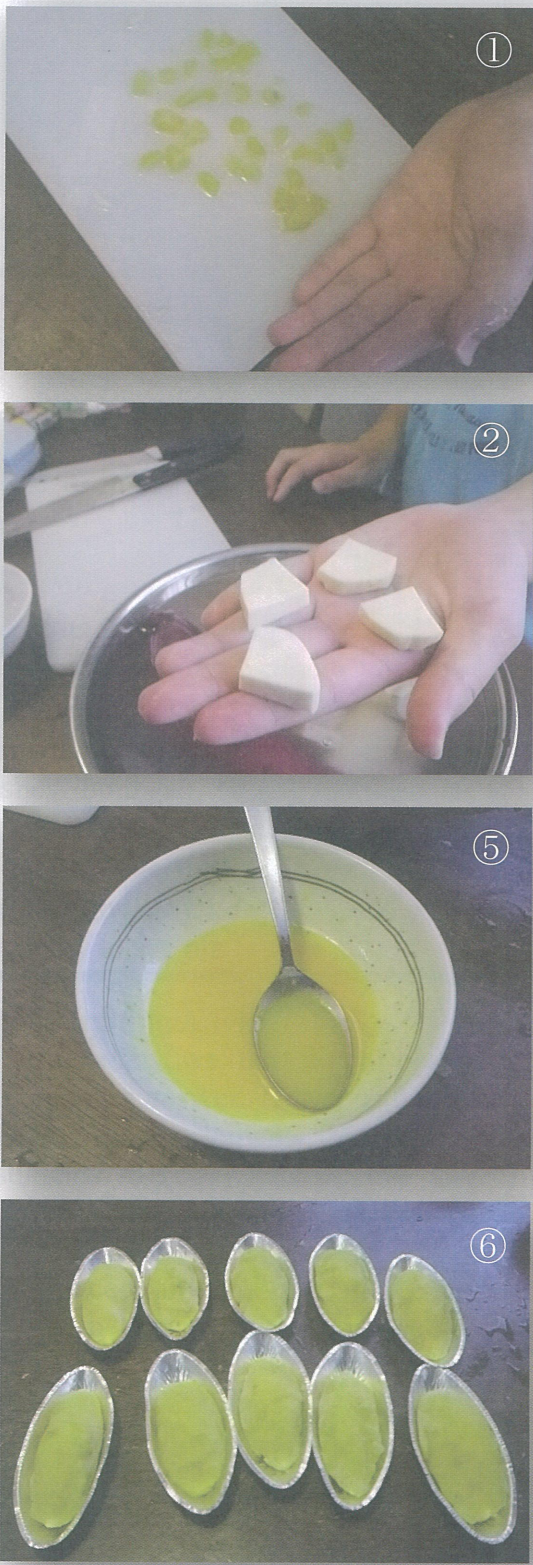
Ingredients:

Sweet potato	about 400g	Milk or fresh cream	50ml
Chestnut	6 to 7	Egg yolk	a half
Butter or margarine	20g	Honey	5 ml
Sugar	20g	Water	5 ml

Makes about ten cakes.

How to cook:

1. Peel the sweet potatoes, slice them into moderate but smallish pieces to cook easily.
2. Put the sweet potatoes into a bowl, cover it with plastic wrap, and microwave it. During microwaving, cut chestnuts into smallish pieces.
3. Mash sweet potatoes while they are still hot. Then, add chestnuts, sugar, milk, and butter, mix them up with a rice scoop.
4. Make sure of its sweetness. If it’s not sweet enough, add sugar. After that, shape the dough into hand-sized like in the picture.
5. Mix up egg yolk, honey, and water, and spread it on cakes with a brush.
6. Bake in a 900W oven for 5 - 10 minutes.



When we cooked this time, we used a spoon instead of a brush at step 5. It is important to spread the mixture of egg yolk, honey, and water on the cakes quickly. If you have purple potatoes, you can cook mixed sweet potato cakes by the same steps 1 to 3. Also, it is delicious to add apples in exchange for chestnuts.

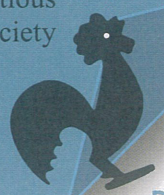

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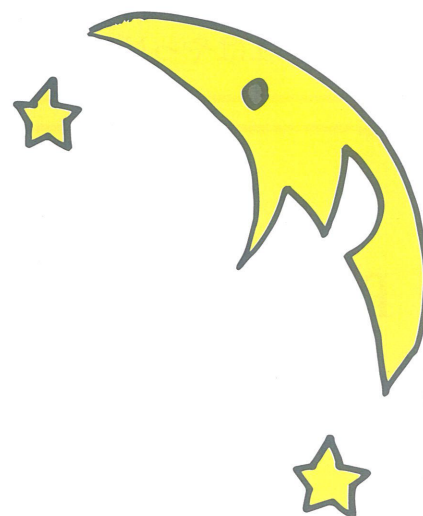
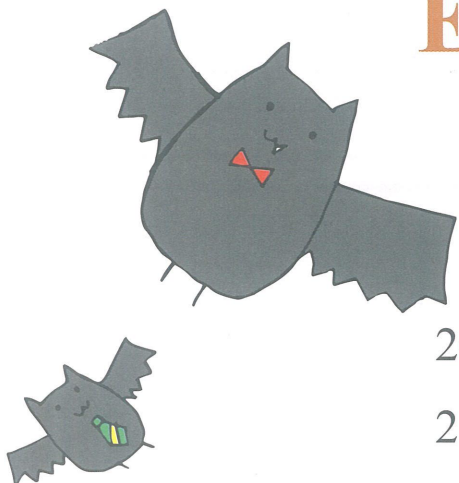
