Extended Deadline: March 31, 2025

Kindai Management Review is the bulletin of Creative Management and Innovation Research Institute (MIRI) at Kindai University in Japan. The first volume (only inaugural issue) was published by Maruzen Planet in February 2013. We are now calling for submissions to be reviewed for possible inclusion in Volume 13. Everybody who is a research, practitioner or Ph.D. candidate in management is welcome to submit a paper. However, it is limited in an unpublished paper. And the licence of publish and reproduce the article in the journal and to communicate it to the public in print or digital form belong to Kindai University.

Kindai Management Review plays two roles. One is to promote the results of research on management in Japan to the world. The other is to receive new theories and methods of management that were developed elsewhere in the world and introduce them into Japan.

Kindai Management Review is a refereed journal. We welcome original papers that have not been published elsewhere that are related to the following topics.

- Creative management and open innovation
- Knowledge creation theory (Nonaka Theory) and knowledge management
- Enterprise's sustainable growth and new business model
- Venture business and entrepreneurship education
- Research on people (management scholar or practitioner, for example, Peter Drucker or Steve Jobs) and management history
- Global management and competitive strategy
- Marketing and customer
- Human resource management and creativity development
- Learning organization and organizational behavior
- Intellectual asset and accounting innovation
- Corporate culture and management philosophy
- Corporate governance and corporate social responsibility
- Other research about new theory or method on management

Manuscripts should be 10-15 pages (A4 size) and the maximum is 20 pages including tables and figures. Please refer to the sample paper for details.
